1. Effort – How much <i>effort</i> will you put into scanning this assignment? Write a statement that describes your effort.	
2. Knowledge – Explain briefly what you already <i>know</i> about the information in this reading.	
3. Will Know – List important information that you <i>will know</i> after reading.	
4. Attract Attention – Relate what attracted your attention as you scanned the reading. Explicate why this caught your attention.	
5. Learning – Briefly explain what you <i>learned</i> from scanning this content.	
6. Evidence – What evidence can show your learning? Describe what you can do at this moment that will demonstrate what you learned.
